This CSCS assessment course in Telescopic Handler Operation is for the experienced operator who has extensive practical experience but has never received any form of initial training. It enables experienced telescopic handler operators to gain recognition for their achievements by way of certification and to comply with statutory regulations.

Aim Of Course

To provide an opportunity for participants to demonstrate their skills, knowledge and attitudes associated with telescopic handler operations and to obtain the appropriate certification.

Programme Content

The programme will consist of a classroom session of underpinning knowledge relating to telescopic handler operations, a one-hour practical test and a one-hour related knowledge test.

Safely operate and control a telescopic handler under no-load and load conditions

Lift and place a variety of loads to towers and trailers

Carry out pre-start checks and walk-around inspection procedures on a telescopic handler

Recognise and use approved hand signals

Recognise the function of all safety indicators and be competent in the use of load charts
