Our Confined Space Awareness course aims to give learners an understanding of the risks involved in working in confined spaces & how to reduce those risks.

Course Objectives:

On completion of this course the learners will be able to;

- Describe the responsibility of the confined space entrant, observer & supervisor
- Understand the confined space rescue procedure
- State the reasons for a confined space entry permit & the steps to follow for obtaining one
- Understand the operation of a gas detector
- Be Aware of the contents of the H.S.A. Approved Code of Practice for Confined Spaces

Course Programme:

- Confined spaces – Definition & Identifying hazards
- Safe work practices & procedures
- Emergency planning – Rescue procedures
- Unsafe atmospheres
- Gas detection equipment

Training Methods:

- A power-point presentation supplemented with videos
- Interactive problem solving & case studies throughout
