Health & Safety at Roadworks

**Protecting you, your colleagues and the public
while you work on a public roadway**

Who should attend: Operatives who are required to work in the proximity of roadworks, in both rural and urban situations, so as to understand the risks to their own safety from passing traffic and the need to avoid creating dangers for road users. This training is mandatory under the Safety, Health and Welfare at Work (Construction) Regulations 2013.

Duration: 1 Day

Objectives: Candidates who successfully complete this course will be trained and motivated to work safely at roadworks and to minimise traffic disruption to road users.
