Who Should Attend

- Be aware of and understand Relevant Legislation.

Requirements

Candidate must have the following:

- Safe Pass Registration Card or CSR Card
- PPE (personal protective equipment), i.e. Hard Hat, High Visibility Vest, Steel Toe Capped Boots, Gloves.



- One Passport Photograph with signature on the back
- PPS Number of National Insurance Number
- Trainee must be over 18
- Must be English speaking
- Must answer **YES** to at least **9** out of **13** questions on the Mobile Access Tower Experienced Operator's Self Assessment document prior to the commencement of the programme
