



### Slinger/Signaller Course

#### **Course Aim:**

The aim of this 1 day (experienced) or 3 day (new entrant) course is to equip learners with the skills, knowledge & understanding for to be a competent Signaller/Slinger

#### **Course Objectives:**

On completion of this course the learners will be;

- Aware of the current Health & Safety Legislation as it applies to Signaller/Slinger
- Able to use & understand hand signals as they apply to Slingers, Signallers
- Able to guide & select appropriate lifting equipment
- Able to recognise hazards & risks associated with blind lifts

#### **Course Programme:**

- Safety, Health & Welfare at Work Act 2005
- Employers & Employees legal duties under current Health & Safety Legislation
- Identify workplace hazards regarding Slinger/Signaller
- Understand the principles for the correct selection of Lifting Equipment
- Identify & apply the full range of Slings & Signaller methods
- Apply & Understand Signaller/Signaller Operations

#### **Training Methods:**

Classroom based presentation on power-point. Learners can practice lifting operations & using hand signals

#### **Who Should Attend?**

Those employees who are responsible for or in control of all lifting equipment

#### **Additional Information:**
